

NOTICE OF TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE

(a) Definitions

As used in this clause:

- (1) “Small business concern,” means a concern, including its affiliates, that is independently owned and operated, not dominant in the field of operation in which it is bidding on Government contracts, and qualified as a small business under the size standards in this solicitation.
- (2) “Offer” includes “bid.”

(b) General

- (1) Offers are solicited only from small business concerns. Offers received from concerns that are not small business concerns shall be considered nonresponsive and will be rejected.
- (2) Any award resulting from this solicitation will be made to a small business concern.

(c) Agreement

A small business concern submitting an offer in its own name shall furnish in performing the subcontract, only end items manufactured or produced by small business concerns in the United States or its outlying areas (see subparagraph 1.2 of the FL-1, General Provisions). If the total amount of the subcontract resulting from this procurement does not exceed \$25,000, a small business concern may furnish the product of any domestic concern. This paragraph does not apply to construction or service subcontracts.
