
To access docdb, go to

<http://mu2e-docdb.fnal.gov/>

Click on “Private.”

In the window that pops up, type in the reviewer username and password that will be provided by email. Click “OK.”

To access a specific document number, type the number into the box preceded by “Mu2e-doc-#.”
